Frequently Asked Questions

When should I have a mammogram?

Breast cancer is best treated when detected early so OhioHealth and the American Cancer Society recommend:

- + Annual mammogram beginning at age 40
- + Annual clinical breast exam by your physician
- + Monthly breast self exams

How do I pay for my mammogram?

Mammogram services are covered by most major health insurance plans. Please check with your health plan for coverage information. OhioHealth offers financial assistance options — ask about these when you call to schedule.

What happens with the results?

Your results will be made available to your OhioHealth primary care physician or OB/GYN within 1-2 business days. Outside physicians will be sent results within 7 to 10 days. A copy of your results will be mailed to you, unless you are enrolled in MyChart, within 7 to 10 days. Women with questionable results will be contacted by an OhioHealth breast health nurse to arrange for additional diagnostic testing.
