Dear Parents,

Your children are invited to join the 2024 Summer Reading Program and attend the fun programs and events we are planning for children entering grades K-6. This summer's theme is "Adventure Begins at Your Library." The programs are **FREE**, and will be presented in person at the Logan Library @ 10:00 AM and the Laurelville Branch shelter house @ 1:00 PM.

The public library cares about your children and has planned programs and prize incentives to keep them reading and learning all summer. Have your child read for 20 minutes a day, 6 days = 2 hours a week or have someone read to them, and they can earn prizes each week. You track the time spent reading using the paper reading log provided by the Library after you turn in your registration. **ALL** children who are participating need to be registered at the library branch they will be attending at! Children who join the library's summer program read to succeed, keeping their minds active and enter school in the fall ready to learn!

The Summer Reading Program is an eight (8) week program beginning Wednesday, June 5, 2024. Your child is invited to participate in a weekly program where they will hear special speakers and participate in activities. A detailed list of the weekly programs is available at your library branch. Please arrive 10 minutes early so your children's reading log can be stamped and receive their weekly reading prize. Parents are required to stay with children younger than 12 years old during the programs. Program attendance is not required to earn prizes but is encouraged. Also, every Wednesday children can receive a free sack lunch at the library! The meals are provided by HAPCAP. Please stop in or contact your library branch for more questions!
